Hebrews 10:24-25

²⁴ And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

We in the Lutheran Church see the service different than other denominations. We focus on God coming down to us to give us His good gifts. Other churches focus on the people going up to God to give Him praise and honor then He is pleased and comes down to His people. We believe it is God who works and acts for us. We come to receive His gifts.

So if you receive communication from an Elder or Elders know we want all people to be part of Zion Lutheran Church and receive the blessings God gives to His people. As one of God's people you can know the joy and peace you can have through Christ Jesus. This goes into our everyday lives and it touches others so they also can have what we have. Let us encourage and build one another up in Christ and meet together.




