

In the busy times we are currently in, handling the finances of our congregation is requiring more and more work. In an effort to save our financial people time we ask that you consider an old idea, that of the Simply Giving Program. To refresh your memory, Simply Giving is a program where once a week, once a month, or twice a month, your offering is automatically deducted from your checking account and automatically deposited into the churches account. All you will need to do is once a week (or whatever you choose) is to record the amount in your check register. That is all there is to it. The amount is set by you and doesn't change unless you request it to be changed or discontinued. Special services like Advent, Lent, Christmas, etc are NOT automatically deducted and we would encourage you to use your offering envelopes for those services just like in the past. An additional bonus would be that our giving throughout the year would be more consistent. We prayerfully ask that you consider making this small change that would be of big help. 

## Is your Family Prepared?

We can't avoid disasters, but we can do things to prepare for them. Failure to plan is a plan to fail!

Do you have a family readiness pack ready to grab in case of a disaster? Make it a family activity. It is also important to discuss your "safe place" in your home.

It is important to establish a contact person who lives outside of your location that each family member will call if your family would be separated after a disaster.

A basic emergency supply kit could include the following recommended items. The first seven items listed can be stored in your "safe place" and it is best to put the rest of the items in a backpack or duffle bag that can easily be grabbed if you need to go to the basement or leave the house. This is a guideline. You can add items to fit your family's needs.

- 1. Water (one gallon per person for several days, for drinking and sanitation)
- 2. Food (at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food) Manual can opener
- 3. Bucket with lid to use as toilet
- 4. Plastic sheeting and duct tape
- 5. Pet food and water
- 6. Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- 7. Paper cups, plates, paper towels and plastic utensils
- 8. Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather radio with tone alert
- 9. Flashlights and extra batteries
- 10. Candles and matches
- 11. Cell phone backup battery
- 12. First-aid kit
- 13. Cash
- 14. Non-prescription medications such as pain relievers
- 15. Several days prescription medications
- 16. Whistle (to signal for help)
- 17. Dust mask (to help filter contaminated air)
- 18. Moist towelettes and garbage bags
- 19. Infant formula, diapers, wipes and bottles
- 20. Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, list of medications, driver's license, etc.
- 21. Paper, pencil, books, games, puzzles, etc. (for children)
