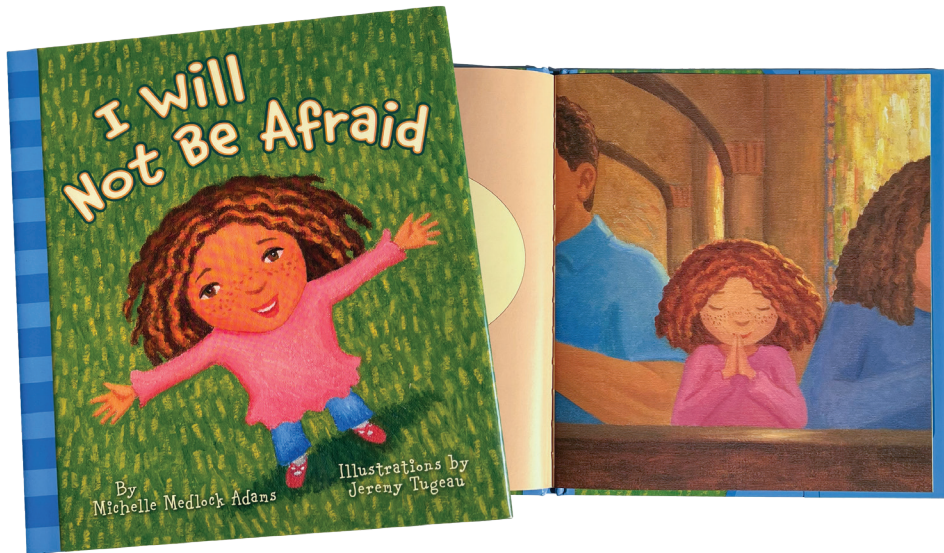

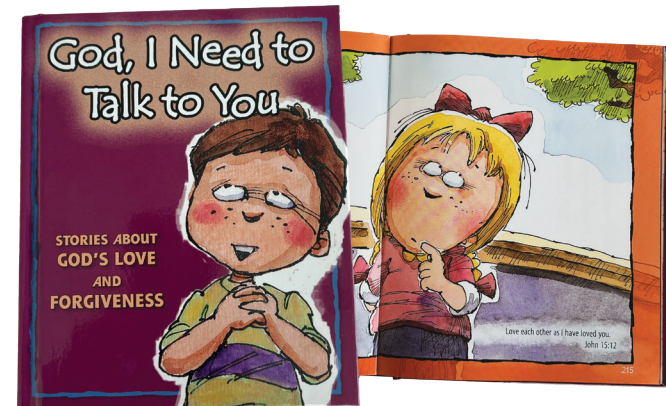
## *I Will Not Be Afraid*
